



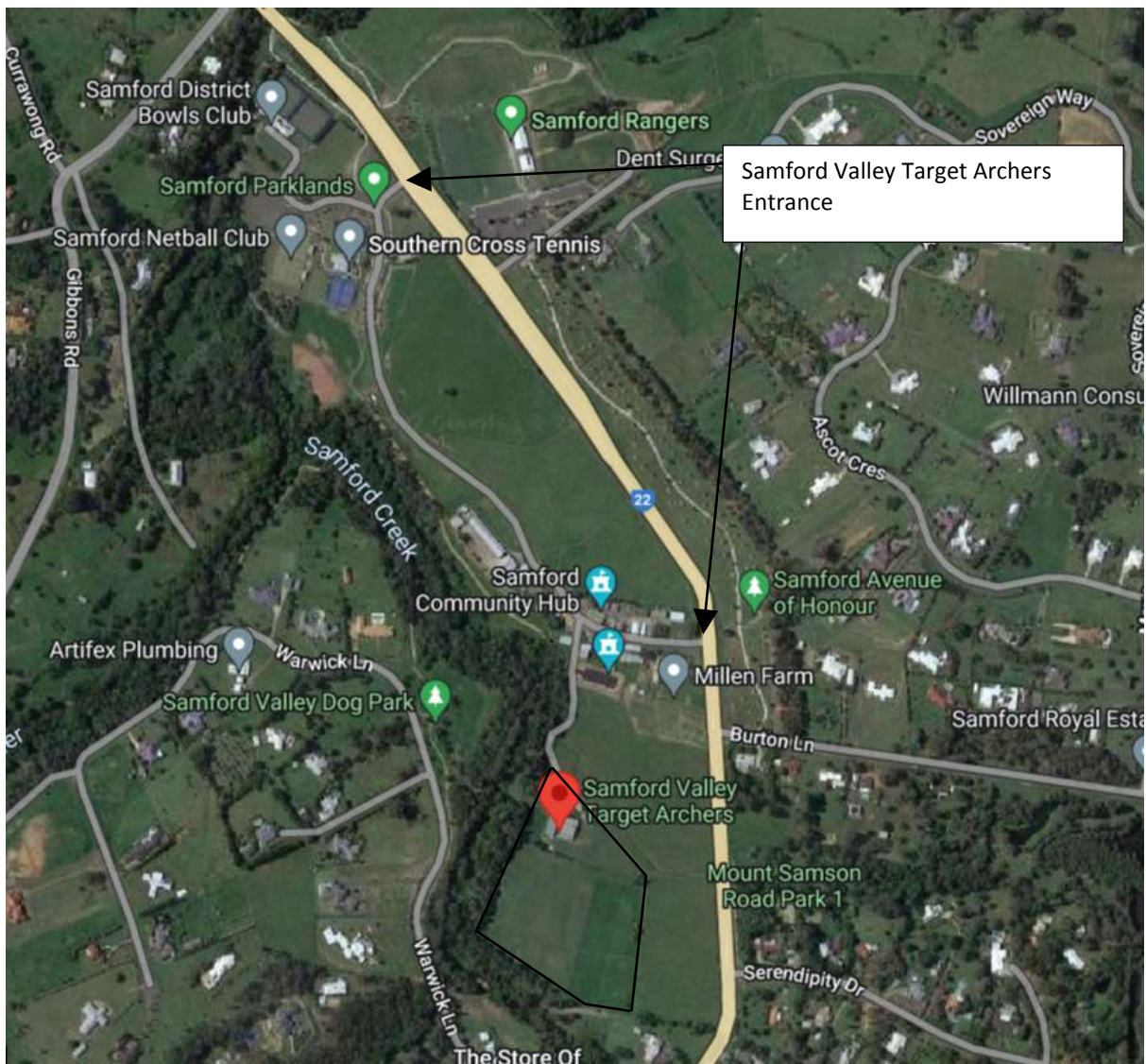

DRESS REGULATIONS:

In order to present the best possible image for our sport, to our sponsors and to the general public, Archery Australia Rule 7.11, Dress Regulations, will be enforced. No apparel depicting hunting type imagery or camouflage. No activewear. No boardshorts.

PRACTICE:

The venue will be open for unofficial practice on Wednesday 28th September from 10.00am – 3.00pm.

1440 ROUND / 6 ARROW ENDS:

All archers will shoot 6 arrow ends for the last two distances of the 1440 round.

Target Faces

All male Open, 50+ and Under 21 recurve archers will shoot on the 80cm10-5 scoring zone target faces.

All compound archers will shoot on the 80cm10-5 scoring zone target faces.

NOTES:

As electronic scoring via Archers Diary will be available for this event, all archers are responsible for ensuring your scores are entered into Archers Diary at the completion of the event.

Please remember to slip, slop, slap, and use insect repellent before shooting, and drink plenty of water during the event.

This tournament will be shot under World Archery, Archery Australia and SQAS rules and policies.

Covid 19 precautions will be required to be followed.

Please advise the organisers if you have any issues with photos being taken by the official photographer.

Competitors are to ensure that you bring your current AA membership card with you as you may not participate without proof of current membership.

Refreshments, etc. will be available from the canteen. There are several take-away outlets a short drive away in Samford Village.
